## STAR-STUDED SPRING SURPRISE ‘LAND OF SOMETIMES’ PREMIERING APRIL 2026

Los Angeles, CA (March 16, 2026) – A magical new family adventure is ready to cast its spell. *The Land of Sometimes* arrives digitally on AppleTV, Google Play, Amazon Prime and Fandango At Home on April 7<sup>th</sup> (\$14.99 to own, \$5.99 to rent), followed by a DVD release (\$19.99) at Walmart and Amazon on June 16<sup>th</sup>, inviting audiences of all ages (with a focus on 5-10 years old) into a wondrous world where imagination reigns and family means everything.



Featuring an extraordinary voice cast, the film stars Asa Butterfield (*Hugo*, *Miss Peregrine’s Home For Peculiar Children*), and The Boy in the Striped Pajamas), Helena Bonham Carter (*Charlie and the Chocolate Factory*, *Harry Potter*), Ewan McGregor (*Star Wars*, *Beauty and the Beast*), Terry Jones (*Monty Python*), EGOT-winner Mel Brooks (*Spaceballs*, *Blazing Saddles*) and his grandson Henry Brooks, Alisha Weir (*Matilda: The Musical*, *Abigail*), Jessica Henwick (*Glass Onion*), and Andrei Shen (*Matilda: The Musical*).

Reminiscent of beloved classic adventures such as *Alice in Wonderland*, *Peter Pan*, and *The Wizard of Oz*, *The Land of Sometimes* is directed by Leon Joosen, produced by Tony Nottage and Nottage Productions, and executive produced by Alan Yentob (*Imagine*, *Mel Brooks and Me*), Bonnie Arnold (*Toy Story*, *How To Train Your Dragon*), Two Daughters executive chairman James Reatchlous and CEO Simon Bobin, and Kaleidoscope Film Distribution CEO Spencer Pollard. The film blends timeless storytelling with rich animation to create a heartfelt cinematic experience for modern audiences.



The story follows twins Alfie and Elise, whose lives are turned upside down when they summon a mysterious Wish Collector and are whisked away to a fantastical realm brimming with unforgettable creatures, surprises at every turn, and an unexpected revelation. As the twins journey through this enchanting world, they discover a truth more powerful than any wish: the enduring strength of family.

Adding to the magic is a vibrant musical score, featuring original songs by singer-songwriter Francesca Longrigg, along with new songs by legendary lyricist and EGOT-winner Tim Rice (*Aladdin*, *The Lion King*, *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*, *Evita*) and Pete Hobbs (*Jean*, *Easy A*). *The Land of Sometimes* marks Rice’s return to animated features after 25 years, making the film a special milestone for musical storytelling.

The film celebrated its World premiere at the 42nd Annual KidFilm Festival on January 17<sup>th</sup>, 2026, and will enjoy a theatrical run at the Laemmle Glendale Theatre in Los Angeles from March 20–26, offering families the chance to experience the magic on the big screen before its home release.
