

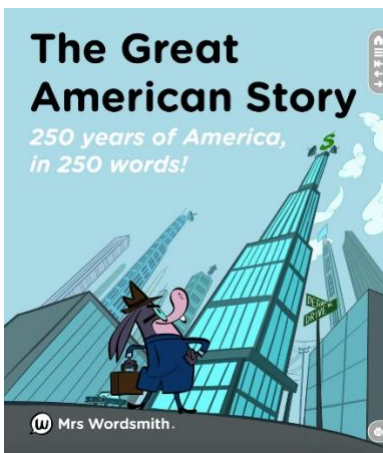

British “Word Wizards” Gift American Families a Free Robust Learning Tool

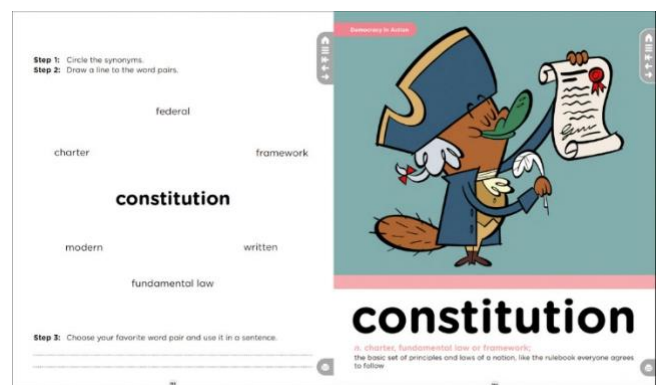
